
A fresh opportunity for Canberra

By investing in a National Convention Centre, the Canberra Liberals will not only increase the vibrancy of the city centre but also provide additional incentives for employers to attract skilled workers to Canberra. This strategic investment will create economic benefits for the ACT and for established businesses in Civic and encourage more businesses to start-up or relocate to Canberra.
