- Vtilising new facilities, such as the Critical Services Building and refurbished North Canberra Hospital threatres, to increase capacity
- Partnering with private providers for high-speed, low-complexity patients, enabling at least 10,000 elective surgeries

By implementing these measures, the policy aims to reduce wait times, alleviate patient suffering, and restore timely access to essential medical procedures.
