Invest in the Tuggeranong Region

Community Infrastructure

The Canberra Liberals will:

- Provide funding of \$5.4 million to the Tuggeranong United Football Club (TUFC) to upgrade their facilities in Kambah.
- Provide funding of \$1.5 million to the Brindabella Blues Football Club at Calwell, to build a new pavilion including changerooms, storage and canteen facilities. The new pavilion will also support local community sporting events such as Little Athletics and local school athletics carnivals.
- Invest in restoring Lake Tuggeranong, with a focus on improving water quality and enhancing biodiversity so that our whole community can enjoy our beautiful lake.
- Continue with the beautification of Tuggeranong town centre by delivering public art, gardens and more facilities like additional bins around the lake.
- Work with the AFL on an integrated partnership for an AFL Hub in Kambah.
- Work with Pickleball ACT to identify a suitable location for an outdoor venue.







Investing in the Tuggeranong region

Parks, Playgrounds and Local Maintenance

The Canberra Liberals will:

- Increase resources for mowing and maintenance to ensure that our local suburbs are tidy, presentable, and safe.
- Allocate additional resources to improve ACT Sportsgrounds' storage and change room facilities as well as undergoing a program of turf improvements and lighting at sports grounds.
- Provide additional funding to renew neglected playgrounds and parks such as Crichton Crescent playground in Kambah and Littler Place playground in Banks.

- Commit to building the Lanyon dog park as a priority.
- Provide additional funding for a footpath maintenance blitz across the ACT.
- Continue to improve access to Mount Taylor and focus on improving access to Big Monks. We will also invest in a Point Hut Park Run path and the beautification of Point Hut Pond.
- Upgrade Tuggeranong Skate Park, and pledge \$35,000 towards a sand arena for the Kambah Horse Paddocks.

Local Shops

The Canberra Liberals will:

- Roll out a revamped program to upgrade local shopping centres, such as Erindale, Kambah and Calwell and undertake community consultation to ensure that our local shops get the improvements they need.
- Help the South Canberra Veteran's Shed find a permanent home, giving certainty to a group that gives back to those who have served our country.
- Provide funding of \$20,000 for the YWCA Mura Lanyon to support them providing youth activities and equipment to our young people in Tuggeranong.

Community Safety

Community safety is the first priority of a Canberra Liberals Government and we will:

- Amend bail laws to protect frontline workers
- Introduce electronic monitoring of serious offenders on bail.
- Hire 200 more police officers for Canberra, to keep our local community safe.
- Create a grants program for local residents for the removal of graffiti on private residential property adjacent to public land.







Investing in the Tuggeranong region

Cost of Living

The Canberra Liberals will alleviate financial pressures by:

- Capping rate increases at 2.2% which will save an average household in the Tuggeranong region more than \$1,500.
- \$150 voucher for every preschool to year 12 student to help with school costs
- \$100 voucher for every preschool to year 12 student to help pay for extracurricular activities.
- Free public transport for students, seniors and concession card holders and capped weekly fares at \$25 each.
- Vehicle registration rebates for passenger vehicles, caravans and camper trailers.

- \$50 household rebate on electricity bills for every household.
- Increase housing affordability by building 125,000 homes by 2050.
- Auctioning off overpriced land, with 10% reserved for first homeowners at 75% of current market value.
- Phasing out stamp duty to reduce the significant cost barriers facing Canberrans wishing to buy a home.
- Provide funding of \$20,000 between YWCA Mura Lanyon, Communities At Work and Gordon Community Centre to support their work in helping those most in need.

Health

The Canberra Liberals' plan for healthcare infrastructure in Tuggeranong region aims to improve accessibility and quality of care through:

- Building a new walk-in centre in South Tuggeranong incorporating GPs to improve access to more services, such as medical imaging, prescriptions, and emergency care.
- Providing incentives to afterhours services such as CALMS to extend their opening hours at the Tuggeranong clinic.
- Delivering 70,000 elective surgeries to reduce surgery wait times.
- Establishing a dedicated endometriosis and pelvic pain clinic in the ACT so women do not have to travel interstate to receive the care they need.







Investing in the Tuggeranong region

Roads, Parking, and Transport

Labor's infrastructure delays have made congestion and road safety worse in Tuggeranong. The Canberra Liberals have a plan to fix this by:

- Introducing a new seven-day bus timetable, so you don't have to wait 2 hours for a bus on the weekends.
- Duplicating Athllon Drive, fixing Labor's broken promise from the last election.
- Upgrading streetlighting to keep pedestrians and motorists safe at night and in dangerous weather.
- Declaring war on potholes, with a pothole repair blitz and the development of a more proactive approach to road maintenance.
- Finish repairing Sulwood Drive, after months of delay under Labor.
- Completing the works to upgrade Monaro Highway.

- Paving and maintaining rural roads so all Canberrans can get home safely.
- Investigating adding a slip lane to the intersection of Isabella Drive and Cockcroft Avenue in Monash, to keep drivers safe on this busy section of road.
- Introducing a busway priority on the Tuggeranong to Woden Athllon Drive corridor, and bus priority measures on Tharwa Drive and Isabella Drive.
- Reinstating peak hour Xpresso bus services from Tuggeranong's suburbs direct to the City via the Parkway and Monaro Highway.
- Trialling on-demand services, as well as opening new locations for Park & Ride facilities and upgrading existing ones, such as the Wanniassa Park & Ride.

Education

Improving the education of young Canberrans will be at the front of mind for a Canberra Liberals Government.

- We will restore the school bus network and identify which parts of Tuggeranong require more dedicated school services.
- We will deliver a fully funded and fully implemented evidence-based approach to literacy and numeracy in all ACT Government schools.
- We will take issues like behaviour management and school maintenance seriously, after years neglect by this Labor-Greens Government.
